CIRCULAR INSTRUCTION NO. 05/2018

DATE : 24th OCTOBER 2018
TO : ALL SPECIAL CABLE TELEVISION OPERATORS

This Circular Instruction serves to inform you that a directive has been issued by the Chief Censor under the Classification of Publication (Censorship) Act, 1989, Regulation.

Any person or entity who solely operates a CABLE TELEVISION reception in which receives signals from foreign stations via a master antenna (Satellite Disc) and receives by cable for his/her own consumption must register its prescribed activity.

As stipulated under Part III of the Classification of Publication (Censorship) Act, 1989 Section 25 – 27, a person shall not establish or operate a prescribed activity, unless the premises, in or on which the activity is to be established or is being operated, are registered under this Act as publication premises.

You are informed to register all your prescribed activity to the Office of Censorship before its operation or establishment.

All Special Cable Television operators are to take immediate steps to effect this directive as of the date of this Circular Instruction. Failure to comply with this Instruction will result in the immediate confiscating of the antenna (Satellite Disc) and your liable to pay a default penalty fine of K1,000.00.

The Office of Censorship will be conducting inspection to all Special Cable Television operators to ensure amenability with the Chief Censor's directives.
