**SUBJECT: BAN ON SONGS CONTAINING VULGAR  
CONTATIONS**

This instruction is to notify all Television and Radio Stations and Entertainment Venues such as night clubs, pubs or bars that the Office of Censorship has put a ban some local songs to air/play on the airwaves or entertainment venues.


These songs contain slangs or phrases which are considered to be vulgar and distasteful or have some form of sexual connotations and portray an utter disrespect towards our womenfolk and reasonable adult person(s) in Papua New Guinea.

The songs include:

- Sigirapim Saksak; Muno Worixx, & Clemz
- Private Nangu; Ragga Siai, Yung D & 5-Star
- Meri Sunam Jaro Local

Furthermore, as part of the exercise to ensure that our Music Industry shows some degree of professionalism in their artistic work, any new songs and musical clips must not be aired without approval from my office.
