CIRCULAR INSTRUCTION NO. 04/2018

TO : ALL TELEVISION STATIONS
SUBJECT : CONSUMER ADVICE

You are all advised that you are required to display appropriate Classification Ratings for Publications (Television Programs and Films) lined up for your daily schedules. Every citizen is entitled to view, read and listen to whatever he/she wishes and is also entitled to protection from exposure to unsolicited or indecent materials or content.

Pursuant to the Classification of Publications (Censorship) Act, 1989, Section 48, subsections (1) and (2), all programs and films must be given an appropriate classification rating before it is consumed by the public.

Therefore, you are hereby strictly instructed to display consumer advice to the public about the classification rating of each television program and film prior to broadcasting of the publication.
